Olpererhütte - Friesenberghaus

Following the tracks of the first Mountaineers and the Alpine Association

The story of the Friesenberghaus began in 1924, four years before building work was started by mountaineers from Berlin. The reason for this was the annexation by the Donauland Section of the German and Austrian Alpine Association. In response, in April 1925, some 630 members of the Berlin Section founded the German Alpine Association Berlin, which built the Friesenberghaus between 1928 and 1930 at one of the best viewing points in the Zillertal Alps. The turbulent events during the war have left deep scars on the Section and on the Hut. In 2000, the German Alpine Association decided to develop the Friesenberghaus into a centre for education and international meetings against prejudice. The building has been used for this purpose since 2003 and the memorial at the approach to the hut reminds visitors of the varied history of their mountain accommodation. The magical „Petersköpfl“ with its fascinating „Steinmandln“ represents the highlight of the hike.

Hintertux Waterfall Trail

The wonders of nature

The Tux waterfalls thunder and roar into the valley. An imposing natural spectacle awaits us. Deep rock calderas, natural bridges of rock, caves, gorges and the Schrauben Waterfall, which is now under conservation, will amaze you! We start at the terminus of the Gletscherbahn (8-seater gondolas) in Hintertux. From here you can already see the „Kesselfall“, the lowest of the waterfalls. The path winds up to the Schrauben Waterfall. On a narrow track, we go through the „Schutzwald“ and pass the so-called „Walfischmaul“ (whale's mouth), a rock formation that really does look like the mouth of a fish. A highlight of the walk is the Tux Stream Gorge and the wonderful „Talkessel“ on the Waldeben. From there, we descend on Path No.16 back to the Valley Station.
