### Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>

Since 1918 the state borderline at the Pfitscherjoch separates North Tyrol from South Tyrol and with it an old common cultural landscape. Only some know about the southern part of the Pfitscherjoch - this hike offers the opportunity to get to know about the other side of the pass with its unique history and nature. Our journey begins with a bus ride from the Zillertal over the Brenner Pass to the city of Sterzing. Before the Zillertal railway was established in 1902, Sterzing was due to its location nearby the Brennerpass easily accessible and therefore vantage point for several hiking tours to the Zillertal. After a guided city tour and coffee break (about 1 hour) the bus takes us further to Pfitsch and the hamlet Stein. From here we start our hike (about 2,5 hours) to the Pfitscherjoch, where it is possible to have lunch at the Pfitscherjoch hut and to enjoy the marvelous view. A comfortable walk of around 1,5 hours leads us to the Schlegeis Reservoir where we catch again our bus. After the opportunity to visit the Nature Park Information Center in the mountaineering village Ginzling the bus continues to Mayrhofen.

#### Across the Border Pfitscherjoch



**Meeting Point:** 7.30 hrs. – Nature Park Information Center in Ginzling  
or 7.50 hrs. – Mayrhofen Station  
(It's possible to get on and off the bus along the main road on request!)

**Dates:** 15.06./04.07./16.07./30.07./13.08./28.08./12.09.

**Duration:** around 8 hours

**Characteristics:** Full-day hike in alpine terrain in parts with an altitude difference of about 700 m  
Sturdy hiking boots are essential!

**Costs:** 32 € including coach (22 € for guests of our partner accommodations and for locals)

**Outward journey:** with the coach via Innsbruck, Brennerpass, Sterzing to Pfitsch

**Return journey:** with the same coach from Schlegeis Reservoir to Ginzling/Mayrhofen

**Stop off possibilities:** several inns in Sterzing; Pfitscherjoch Haus, Jausensation Zammgatterl

**Duration:** approx. 3 hours

**Characteristics:** an easy walk around the town centre

**Costs:** free

**Stop of possibilities:** several inns in Mayrhofen



#### Trekking with Llamas and the Tux Mill

Along the Tux Stream Adventure Trail

Together with our four-legged friends, we take a leisurely walk along the roaring Tux Stream from Vorderlanersbach to Hintertux, allowing plenty of time to enjoy the wonderful landscape with all our senses. Walk one of the „South Americans“ yourself using its head collar, or simply enjoy their gentle pace. En route, we delve into history at the Tux Mill. The water-powered mill from 1839 is still operated in summer by the miller. From the historical rural artefacts, you can see how corn used to be ground into flour.

**Duration:** around 5 hours

**Characteristics:** an easy walk on good terrain

**Costs:** 5 € per person (guests of our partner accommodations are free of charge)

Arrival 9.56 Vorderlanersbach Rastkogelbahn Departure 15.29/16.04
