Nature Watch

A comfortable ride by „hikers' taxi“ up to the Bergkäserei Stoankasern (1,984 m). It is surrounded by cow pastures, nestling in the wildly romantic Junsbachtal. A very tasty cheese is produced up here throughout the year. We follow the „Junsbach“ up stream, through the „Tote Klamm“ (gorge), until we reach the „Junssee“ (lake), which is only free of ice in high summer. Equipped with new generation binoculars from Swarovski Optik, we embark on a nature watch tour in the magnificent wilderness of the Tux Valley. Our experienced walking guide has lots to explain – from chamois or eagles, marmots or protected Alpine plants, not forgetting the geology.

Secrets of the Eternal Ice

The Berliner Hütte Glacier Trail in the Zemmgrund

Alpine glaciers and their future has long been the subject of much debate. Most of the imposing ice crust is in danger of disappearing from the Alps during the next decades. At the very least, they are contracting year on year and appear to be a type of pulse measurement for climate change. You can experience the glaciers of the Zillertal Alps at close range on the Glacier Trail, which was opened in 2005 around the listed Berliner Hütte! The trail runs along the apron of the glacier and, for those interested in doing so, a detour to the snout of the Hornkees glacier can be made. Learn all about glaciers, how they occur, their inner workings, their environment – let yourself be amazed by the glacial ice and landscape in the Zemmgrund!
