Magnificent Alpine Flowers on the „Bergmähder“ Trail

A panoramic walk from Brandberg to the Kolmhaus

We walk through the meadows of Brandberg, then we take the Bergmähder Trail from Brandberg up to the Kolmhaus at 1,845m. The Bergmähder Trail takes us on the sunny side of the Zillertal Alps, a part of the landscape which has been cultivated for centuries. The Alpine meadows around the sunny village of Brandberg formed the basis for livestock farming within the Nature Park community for many years. The coexistence of cut and uncut meadows, forests and pastures, chalk and primary rock provide the basis for the rich flora along the Bergmähder Trail. You will be rewarded for the climb not only by the many colourful Alpine flowers such as orchids and gentian, but also have a splendid view of the Zillertal Alps from the Kolmhaus.

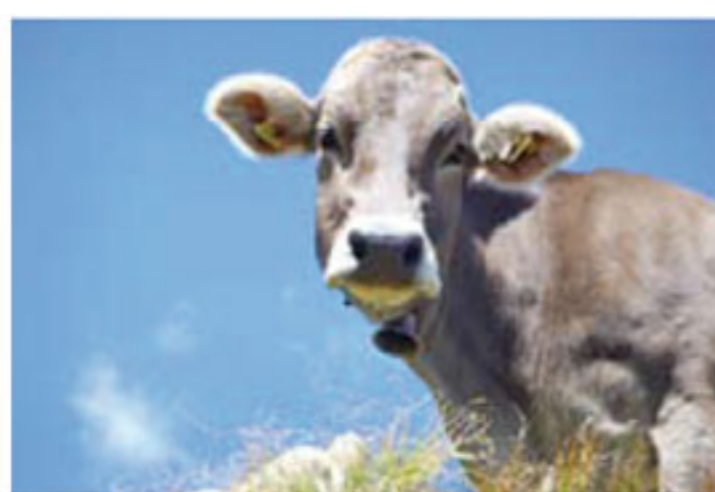
